Responsibilities:

- Web site and multimedia development - creation of graphics, interface design, computer animation, Flash (design and scripting), integration of multiple document formats for use online and on CD-ROM, creation of titles and 'chirons' for television broadcast, creation of interactive projected animation for conference presentation, support of Multimedia Production Services for all interface, internet, screen and print graphic needs.

Accomplishments:

- Multimedia Production Services Web site - directed a team of designers through the conceptualization, design, publication and maintenance of large multimedia web site. This full-serviced site presented four major groups (Video Production, Event production, Streaming Media, and Interactive Media) to the global community of Morgan Stanley. It employed a variety of media technologies including, but not limited to: Flash, RealMedia, Quicktime, SMIL, database, CGI, and .PDF. Due to overwhelmingly positive user response, the look-and-feel was adopted as a brand for the entire division.
- Streaming Media Interfaces - created modular interfaces for Streaming Media department. These Flash interfaces were carefully designed using ActionScript, Java, and SMIL, to allow for fast and simple adaptation and publishing of intranet presentations making use of synchronized audio, video, and PowerPoint slides. An intern with an afternoon's training was able to quickly convert a client's files into a polished product. The system I devised was later adapted for the interface of Morgan Stanley Internet Radio, globally.
- MSDWTV Schedule - creation of easily updatable schedule for Morgan Stanley business television station. This Flash schedule generated itself completely from information retrieved from a simple text file prepared by non-technical personnel.

This included the design and creation of original interface, graphic content and illustration, music and sound, complex action scripting, and JavaScripting to deliver a wide variety of media content including, but not limited to: Flash, Director, Quicktime, and .PDF.
- Promotional Movie - directed a team of three designers in the creation of 40 second animation to advertise the roll-out of the New Media Team's site. This included collaborating with PR consultant, development of content (original illustration and music), animation, and distribution through intranet email.
- UBS O'Connor Web site - directed a team of two designers in the creation of web site for the internal use of new UBS division. This included working with client to develop a system of easily updatable structure and delivery for very dynamic informational web site, the generation of a simple and concise yet forward-focused interface, the creation of original graphic material, and links to several client-maintained data archives.
